ORDINANCE NO. 44 series of 2020

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE GUIDELINES AND REGULATING MOBILITY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL DECLARED AS ONE OF THE AREAS UNDER MODIFIED ENHANCED **COMMUNITY QUARANTINE**

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte placed Metro Manila and Provinces of Laguna, Cavite, Rizal, and Bulacan under a Modified Enhanced Community Ouarantine (MECO), effective August 4, 2020;

WHEREAS, to ensure continuity of the national agencies effort and measures to cascade down to the local community for implementation plan in battling the effect of COVID-19 Pandemic, an updated local legislation of guidelines for this purpose is needed;

WHEREAS, the 11th Sangguniang Bayan finds the need to amend the existing Ordinances to best serve the purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, in session assembled, hereby Prescribes the guidelines and regulating mobility in the Municipality of Taytay, Province of Rizal declared as one of the areas under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ):

Section 1. Curfew Hours - From 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM

Exempted from the curfew hours are Authorized Person Outside of Residence (APOR) going to and from work.


Section 2. Elderly and Youth – Any person below twenty-one (21) years old, those who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidities, or health risk, and pregnant women, including any person who resides with the aforementioned, shall be required to remain in their residence at all times, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods and services or for work in permitted industries and offices.

Section 3. Home Quarantine Pass / COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass - No person shall be allowed to go out of their homes and shall not be allowed to purchase any goods without presenting their Home Quarantine Pass / COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass. The COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass will be issued by the Philippine National Police — Taytay (PNP Taytay) together with Purok / Sitio Chairman in the five Barangays, One Pass per Household, free of charge and shall not be sold. Violators will be dealt with accordingly.

Local Government Employees' ID and Health Workers ID can be used as Home Quarantine Pass for purchase of essential goods and work-related purposes only.

The new Quarantine Pass will be distributed and shall be called COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass.

The Old Quarantine Pass shall be honored until August 6, 2020 only.



Section 4. Travel Pass and Travel Authority

Travel Pass – for the transport of Essential Goods a Travel pass may be issued by the Office of the Mayor provided that the company's Business Permit and IDs be presented.

Work Travel Pass may be issued to employees working in areas under ECQ/MECQ as required by the checkpoint personnel with 15 days validity and can be renewed if necessary.

Employees/Workers going traveling to work on offices and industries permitted to operate hereunder may be required to present their Certificate of Employment/Company ID, COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass is not necessary.

Delivery of orders within Taytay for personal consumption need not apply for a Travel Pass.

Travel Authority – The Travel Authority is issued by the Taytay Philippine National Police for Locally Stranded Individuals (LSI) and Repatriated Overseas Filipino Worker (ROF). The following Requirement shall be submitted to the Office Operation Section of Taytay Municipal Police Station (Kadalagahan St., Begy. Dolores, Taytay, Rizal Contact Nos. 0936-9507608 / 8 685 7267). Strictly Incomplete Requirements, No Travel Pass Authority

- 1. Barangay Clearance
- 2. Medical Health Certificate stating that the LSI/ROFs is neither a contact suspect of probable or confirmed COVID Cases.
- 3. Letter Request from Applicant/Requesting Party indicating the following:
 - a. Names with Contact Number
 - b. Point of Origin and Destination
 - c. Travel Date
 - d. Purpose
 - e. Details of vehicle with Plate Number (OR/CR) and Photocopy of Driver's License of the driver.

Issuance of Travel Authority is subject to the Guidelines issued by the National Agencies concerned.

Section 5. Government Offices – As per Memorandum Circular No. 79 from the Office of the President; all government agencies and instrumentalities of the executive branch, including GOCCs, located in all geographical areas places under MECQ, shall adopt a skeleton workforce up to a maximum of 50% operational capacity at any given time, unless a higher operational capacity is required in agencies providing health and emergency frontline services, border control, and other critical services.

Section 6. Transportation

Public transportation shall be suspended. This notwithstanding, commissioned shuttle services for employees of permitted offices or establishments, as well as point-to-point transport services provided by the government shall be allowed to operate, giving priority to healthcare workers.

Private transportation such as company shuttles and personal vehicles utilized by persons authorized outside their residences are allowed subject to the guidelines provided by DOTr. The use of bikes and other non-motorized transportation is strongly encouraged.

A. Tricycle

The Taytay Municipal Tricycle Franchising and Regulatory Office (TMTFRO) issued the necessary guidelines in particular for implementation under the MECQ dated August 4, 2020.





B. Motorcycle

This shall be governed/regulated according to the Memorandum on Motorcycle Pillion Riding or Backriding under the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine in NCR and Province of Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna and Rizal issued by the Philippine National Police Directorate for Operations dated August 3, 2020.

C. Shuttle Service

The Local Government Unit of Taytay shall provide free shuttle services within the bounds of Taytay for MEDICAL HEALTH WORKERS ONLY who will be reporting for work and going home. The official company ID of the MEDICAL HEALTH WORKERS shall be presented to the shuttle service provider to be allowed access to the service.

Section 7. Establishments Allowed to Operate – No person shall be allowed entry to any establishments within the Municipality without facemasks and face shields.

Likewise, no persons shall be allowed entry to any establishments without Quarantine Pass / Zonal Pass presented. Except for Health Workers and Government Employees.

The following shall be allowed to operate at full operational capacity:

- a. All establishments, persons, or activities permitted to operate, work, or be undertaken under Section 2(4) of the IATF Omnibus Guidelines on the implementation of Community Quarantine;
- b. Media establishments, without need of PCOO accreditation;
- c. BPOs and export-oriented establishments, without need to set up onsite or nearsite accommodation arrangements;
- d. E-commerce companies;
- e. Other postal and courier services, as well as delivery services for articles or products not mentioned under Section 2 of the IATF Omnibus Guidelines on the implementation of Community Quarantine;
- f. Rental and leasing, other than real estate, such as vehicles and equipment for permitted sectors;
- g. Employment activities that involve the recruitment and placement for permitted sectors; and
- h. Housing services activities, such as but not limited to plumbing, roofing, and electrical works.

The following offices, establishments or individuals conducting or providing the following activities or services are allowed to operate at **fifty percent (50%) operational capacity**, while encouraging work-from-home and other flexible work arrangements, where applicable:

- a. Other manufacturing industries classified as beverages, including alcoholic drinks; electrical machinery; wood products and furniture; non-metallic products; textiles and clothing/wearing apparels; tobacco products; paper and paper products; rubber and plastic products; coke and refined petroleum products; other non-metallic mineral products; computers, electronic and optical products; electrical equipment; machinery and equipment; motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers; other transport equipment; and others;
- b. Other real estate activities;
- c. Administrative and office support such as, but not limited to, providing photocopying and billing services;
- d. Other financial services not mentioned in Section 2 of the IATF Omnibus Guidelines on the implementation of Community Quarantine, such as, money exchange, insurance, reinsurance and non-compulsory pension funding;

- e. Legal and accounting services;
- f. Management consultancy services or activities;
- g. Architectural and engineering activities, including technical testing and analysis;
- h. Science and technology, and research and development;
- i. Recruitment and placement agencies for overseas employment.
- j. Advertising and market research;
- k. Computer programming and information management services;
- 1. Publishing and printing services;
- m. Film, music and television production;
- n. Photography, fashion, and industrial, graphic and interior design:
- o. Wholesale and retail trade of vehicles and their parts and components;
- p. Repair and maintenance of vehicles as well as its parts or components, including car wash services;
- q. Malls and commercial centers, subject to the guidelines issued by the DTI;
- r. Dining establishments and restaurants, but for delivery and take-out only;
- s. Hardware stores;
- t. Clothing and accessories;
- u. Bookstore and school and office supplies;
- v. Baby or infant care supplies;
- w. Pet food and pet care supplies;
- x. Information technology, communications and electronic equipment;
- y. Flower, jewelry, novelty, antique and perfume shops; and
- z. Toy stores, Provided, that their playgrounds and amusement areas, if any, shall remain closed;
- aa. Firearms and ammunition trading establishments, subject to strict regulation of the PNP-Firearms and Explosives Office; and
- bb. Pastors, priests, rabbi, imams, and other religious ministers insofar as providing home religious services to households. Provided that proper protocols shall be observed, such as social distancing, wearing of face masks and the like.
- A. Food Establishments shall be allowed to operate for take-out and delivery only from 5:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Food handlers shall be required to wear protective/transport masks, gloves and hairnet at all times. All customers are highly encouraged to bring their own containers and bags for the said purpose. All establishments shall provide queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.
- B. Supermarkets/Groceries/Convenience Stores/Drug Store/Pharmacy/Sari-Sari Store shall be allowed to operate for twelve (12) hours but not exceeding curfew hours, the sari-sari store shall be allowed to operate only for essential products from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, provided that social Distancing is observed at all times especially when queuing for payment. All establishments shall provide queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.
- C. Mall Hours Operation Time of allowed establishments / Tenants shall be from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM, except supermarket and pharmacy that shall follow Section 7.B of this Ordinance. NO face mask and face shield, no entry and Restricted Persons (as stated in Section 3.13 of the IATF Omnibus guidelines on implementation of Community Quarantine) shall not be allowed entry.



Section 8. Establishments NOT Allowed to Operate

- a. Tourist destinations such as water parks, reservation service and related services;
- b. Entertainment industries such as cinemas, theaters, and karaoke bars;
- c. Kid amusement industries such as playroom and kiddy rides;
- d. Libraries, archives, museums and cultural centers;
- e. Gyms, fitness studios and sports facilities; and
- f. Personal care services such as massage parlors, sauna, facial care and waxing.

Section 9. Market Place – this pertains TO all public and private market, recognized talipapas and ambulant vendors / sidewalk vendors in the municipality. It is mandatory to wear Facemask and Face Shield for all stall holders / vendors, buyers / market goers, market suppliers / delivery personnel and Market Personnel assigned by the LGU.

- A. New Taytay Public Market/Old Market shall be in operation from 5:00 AM to 12:00 NN and 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM. All personnel assigned to the NTPM/EEDM shall regularly monitor that social distancing is being strictly observed by all market goers and vendors at all times. Color coding for market goers will be implemented wherein those with BLUE stickers provided by the EEDM shall be allowed entry to public markets on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and those with BLACK stickers on Tuesdays, Thursday and Saturdays. No color coding is in place during Sundays. RED stickers shall be provided to Dealers, Sellers, Suppliers and Hauling Personnel. No COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass, No Buy policy shall be observed by the sellers. All establishments shall provide queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.
- B. All Recognized Talipapas shall operate from 5:00 AM to 12:00 NN and 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM only.
- C. Ambulant Vendors/Sidewalk Vendors shall be prohibited across the municipality at all times

Section 10. Tiangge – Those operators and vendors who already applied for the re-opening of their Tiangge and has been given permit to operate prior to this Ordinance shall be allowed with 30% capacity operation subject to minimum public health protocols. Those who have a pending application after this ordinance shall be put on hold.

Section 11. Total Liquor Ban - The sale of all types of alcoholic drinks shall be prohibited until the MECQ is lifted. Signage of the liquor ban shall be posted in selling areas of the stores. Consuming of any Alcoholic drinks in public places is hereby prohibited.

Section 12. Videoke Rental – The rent/lease of Videoke machines shall be prohibited to avoid the spreading of disease/virus thru the use of communal microphones.

Section 13. Gatherings – All forms of gambling shall be prohibited specially in wakes. Visiting wakes shall be encouraged to be until 7:00 PM only. All sports activities and leagues shall be suspended. All multi-purpose gyms and courts shall be closed for public gatherings and any sports activities. All common religious congregations shall be discouraged to avoid the spread of the virus. All festivities and traditional acts such as Senakulo, Penitensya and the likes are likewise prohibited. Only a maximum of five (5) persons is allowed to be physically present for religious gathering.

Section 14. Waste Segregation. — All households are mandated to observe proper waste segregation and waste disposal as the hauling and collection of garbage is currently hampered by the current community quarantine from adjacent areas.

Section 15. Closure of Roads – The Municipal Mayor is authorized to issue closure of roads, if necessary, as a preventive measure for the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Section 16. Schools – Physical classes at all levels shall be suspended for the duration of the MECQ.

Section 17. Constructions – As per Department Order No. 39 series of 2020 from the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Essential and priority projects shall be allowed to operate subject to strict compliance with the Revised Construction Safety Guidelines; provided however, that small scale projects shall not be allowed during the MECQ.

Section 18. Monitoring and Implementation. – Philippines National Police (PNP-Taytay), The Local Government Unit of Taytay and all Barangay Local Government Units shall monitor and implement the provisions of this ordinance. They shall strictly monitor that all establishments are providing queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.

Section 19. Penalty Clause – A fine of ₱ 2,500.00 shall be imposed and/or imprisonment for 10 to 30 days at the discretion of the proper court for individual violator for every violation of the provisions of this ordinance. Subsequent/habitual violations may lead to the revocation of Business Permits (for business establishments) and Closure of concerned to a maximum of three (3) days, likewise, failure to comply with the "No COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass, No selling" shall result in the same.

Section 20. Information Dissemination – The Public Information Office of this Municipality and the Barangay shall spearhead the information dissemination of this ordinance. Official details regarding COVID-19 updates from the municipality shall come from official memorandum issued by Municipal Health Office and posted at the official page of the Taytay Public Information Office.

Section 21. Separability Clause- If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.

Section 22. Effectivity Clause – This ordinance shall take effect immediately and upon approval. This Ordinance shall likewise be in effect everytime that the municipality is declared under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine by the National Government.

Section 23. Colatilla – Policies shall be stricter from time to time as the need arises. All statutes and policies by the Local Government Unit of Taytay shall be on a day to day basis based on the pronouncements of National Government Agencies or higher offices.
