ORDINANCE NO. 739 series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING CASH AID TO ALL QUALIFIED REGISTERED PERSONS WITH DISABILITY OR DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS AND SOLO PARENTS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL, UPON THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS THEREOF AND BE SUBJECT TO ALL LAWS AND AUDITING RULES AND PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the equal right of all persons with disabilities to live in the community, with choices equal to others and shall take effective and appropriate measures of participation in the Community;

WHEREAS, Community services and facilities for the general population are available on an equal basis to persons with disabilities and all those solo parents who are responsive to their need;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health and other social services available to all the people at

affordable cost and shall prioritize needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children;

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of the Philippines it states that "Local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them and shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, this cash incentive would be a big help to those PWDs and Solo Parents in the Municipality of Taytay, Rizal whose livelihood activities are limited to their conditions and status;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Taytay, Rizal, in session assembled, by virtue of powers vested in it by law, that:

Short Title - This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Providing Cash Aid to all qualified registered PWDs and Solo Parents of the Municipality of Taytay, Rizal"

Purpose - The purpose of this Ordinance is to extend assistance to support Section 2. the needs of those registered and resident PWDs and Solo Parents of this Municipality.

## **Definition of Terms** Section 3.

Persons with Disability a. PWD b. PDAO Persons with Disability Assistance Office

Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office c. MSWDO any individual who falls under any of the following d. Solo Parent

categories:

- 1. A woman who gives birth as a result of rape and other crimes against chastity even without a final conviction of the offender: Provided, That the mother keeps and raises the child;
- 2. Parent left solo or alone with the responsibility of parenthood due to death of
- 3. Parent left solo or alone with the responsibility of parenthood while the spouse is detained or is serving sentence for a criminal conviction for at least one (1)
- 4. Parent left solo or alone with the responsibility of parenthood due to physical and/or mental incapacity of spouse as certified by a public medical practitioner;
- Parent left solo or alone with the responsibility of parenthood due to legal separation or de facto separation from spouse for at least one (1) year, as long as he/she is entrusted with the custody of the children;
- 6. Parent left solo or alone with the responsibility of parenthood due to declaration of nullity or annulment of marriage as decreed by a court or by a church as long as he/she is entrusted with the custody of the children;
- 7. Parent left solo or alone with the responsibility of parenthood due to abandonment of spouse for at least one (1) year;
- Unmarried mother/father who has preferred to keep and rear her/his child/children instead of having others care for them or give them up to a welfare institution;
- 9. Any other person who solely provides parental care and support to a child or children;

A change in the status or circumstance of the parent claiming benefits under this Act, such that he/she is no longer left alone with the responsibility of parenthood, shall terminate his/her eligibility for these benefits.

- e. Children
- refer to those living with and dependent upon the solo parent for support who are unmarried, unemployed and not more than eighteen (18) years of age, or even over eighteen (18) years but are incapable of self-support because of mental and/or physical defect/disability.
- **Section 4. Qualified Beneficiaries** The MSWD, in coordination with the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO) and the Solo Parent Office, shall set the qualifications to identify the beneficiaries of the PWDs and Solo Parents.

Those beneficiary of PWDs may vary to the following classification:

- a. abandoned & abused
- b. independent living
- c. indigent, impairment & disabled gifted,
- d. marginalized disabled persons,
- e. mental disability
- f. neglected orthopedically handicapped
- g. persons with hearing and visual impairment.

If the beneficiary is a Solo Parent, he or she should provide parental care and support to the children and all those categories mentioned in Section 3 of the Solo Parents' Welfare Act of 2000 also known as Republic Act 8972.

- **Section 5. Validity and Monitoring** Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) shall conduct the verification, validation and Monitoring of the PWDs and the Solo parent.
- **Section 6. Appropriation** The appropriating fund necessary for this cash aid shall be included in the Annual Budget of this Municipality for the yearly implementation of this Ordinance.
- **Section 7. Manner of Giving Cash Aid** All qualified beneficiaries shall be given a cash aid every year that will start in the amount of P 2,000.00. Such amount shall be subject to increase annually or upon the discretion of the Local Chief Executive and the availability of funds thereof.
- **Section 8. Separability Clause -** Any section or portion of this Ordinance that shall be declared by any Court as unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of other Sections or provisions of this Ordinance and shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 9. Repealing Clause** All other ordinances, rules and regulations that are in conflict or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- **Section 10. Effectivity Clause -** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
