**ORDINANCE NO. 792 series of 2023**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP AND  
EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO TAYTAYEÑO STUDENTS  
ENROLLED AT RIZAL NATIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL, PROVIDING  
FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, Article 14, Section 1 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides for the protection and promotion of the rights of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, Article 14, Section 2(3) of the aforesaid Philippine Constitution also provides for the establishment and maintenance of a system of scholarship grant, subsidies, and other incentive which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, specially to the underprivileged;

WHEREAS, scholars that are studying in one of the prestigious schools in Rizal bring honor and pride to the Municipality of their residence therefore having them part of the LGUs scholarship program is one way to show importance to these students;

WHEREAS, the Local Government of Taytay has been giving financial educational assistance to Taytayenos enrolled at Rizal National Science High School for several years now although an ordinance specifically for this has yet to be adopted by the Sangguniang Bayan;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay have amended the Municipality's scholarship program guidelines in 2008, 2011 and 2014 respectively and it is now long overdue for updating to further improve the process of selection and to cover added qualified and deserving students from Taytay, however this does not specifically include guidelines for the automatic qualifications of those enrolled at Rizal National Science High School;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the 12<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in a session duly assembled, that:

**Section 1. Title** - This Ordinance shall be known as the **RIZAL NATIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ORDINANCE OF 2023.**

**Section 2. Coverage** - There shall be a Taytay Municipal Scholarship and Educational Assistance Program (TMSEAP) exclusive for all qualified / eligible students enrolled at Rizal National Science High School who are bonafide residents of Taytay, Rizal according to the following categories:

- Junior High School Students - Grades 7, 8, 9 & 10
- Senior High School Students - Grades 11 & 12

**Section 3. Scholarship Committee** - the Taytay Youth Development Office (TYDO) shall serve as the Scholarship Committee and shall spearhead the evaluation of enrollees with consultation and coordination with the Coordinator and Principal of Rizal National Science High School pursuant to this Ordinance and the Implementing Rules and Regulations.

**Section 4. Qualifications** - Scholars of the program under this Ordinance must have the following qualifications:

**4.1** Officially enrolled at Rizal National Science High School as certified by the School Coordinator thru a list forwarded to the Taytay Youth Development Office.

**4.2** A Barangay Certificate of Residency from the Barangay where the student is currently a bonafide resident and a copy of the attached proof of residency or billing address of Parents or IDs with address or Purok Chairperson or HOA President Certifications be submitted.

**4.3** For SY 2025 onwards, a copy of the Voter's Registration of the Parents for ineligible voters or Voter's Registration of Students eligible for Comelec registration.

No examinations or interviews shall be placed as requisites in availing of this scholarship.

**Section 5. Releasing of Educational Assistance** - the Youth Development Office shall schedule the release of the scholarship between the 4th week of September to the 1st week of October of every year and shall not be simultaneous to the release of the educational financial assistance for the Municipal Scholars.

Electronic type of payout system shall be prioritized for this program.

**Section 6. Matrix of Educational assistance for eligible student Taytayeyños enrolled at Rizal National Science High School:**

Grades 7, 8, 9 & 10 (Junior High School Students) - a minimum amount of Php 4,000 per student  
Grades 11 & 12 (Senior High School Students) - a minimum amount of Php 5,000 per student

**Section 7. Appropriation** - The amount of a minimum of Php 1,000,000.00 shall be allocated in the yearly Executive Budget to be used for the financial and scholarship program under this Ordinance as part of the total budget allocated for the Taytay Expanded Scholarship and Educational Assistance Program.


**Section 8. Repealing Clause** - All Ordinances contrary to this Ordinance are deemed repealed accordingly.

**Section 9. Effectivity** - This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its approval and the implementation shall start for the academic year 2024 onwards.
