ORDINANCE NO. 854 series of 2025

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A ONE-WAY TRAFFIC FLOW, ONE-SIDE PARKING REGULATION, AND OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES TO ADDRESS TRAFFIC CONGESTION AND ROAD SAFETY IN THE VICINITY OF THE RIZAL PROVINCIAL HOSPITAL SYSTEM (RPHS), AND MINOR BASILICA AND PARISH OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST, MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL AND SURROUNDING AREAS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Article 11, Section 5 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution declares that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(v) and (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants the Sangguniang Bayan the authority to regulate the use of streets and public places, including the power to regulate traffic and prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, in the interest of public welfare

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Taytay, Rizal has recognized the urgent need to implement structured traffic and parking management in the vicinity of the Rizal Provincial Hospital System (RPHS), and Minor Basilica and Parish of St. John the Baptist - Taytay, Rizal, and surrounding areas to address worsening congestion, ensure road safety, and secure unobstructed access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the 13th Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Short Title - This ordinance shall be known the “*Taytay Poblacion Traffic Scheme Ordinance*”.

Section 2. Scope - This Ordinance shall apply to all kinds of motor vehicles, public and private, within the vicinity of the Rizal Provincial Hospital System (RPHS) - Taytay and Minor Basilica and Parish of St. John the Baptist - Taytay, Rizal; particularly covering the following streets:

- a. Kadalagahan Street
- b. J. Sumulong Street
- c. L. Wood Street
- d. Mahinhin Street
- e. S. Mateo Street
- f. J. Asilo Street
- g. Rizal Avenue

Section 3. Declaration of Policy - In the interest of public safety, smooth vehicular flow, and unobstructed emergency access, the streets surrounding the Rizal Provincial Hospital System (RPHS) – Taytay and Minor Basilica and Parish of St. John the Baptist – Taytay, Rizal are hereby declared subject to one-way, no entry, no parking, and one-side parking regulations, as specifically provided under this Ordinance.

Section 4. One-Way Streets - The following streets are hereby declared as one-way thoroughfares:

- a. Kadalagahan Lower – Rizal Avenue going to Minor Basilica
- b. Kadalagahan Upper – Minor Basilica going to L. Wood
- c. J. Sumulong Lower – L. Wood going to Minor Basilica
- d. J. Sumulong Upper – Minor Basilica going to Rizal Avenue
- e. Mahinhin – Kadalagahan going to Mahinhin corner S. Mateo
- f. J. Asilo Upper – J. Sumulong going to L. Wood

Section 5. Two-Way Streets - The following streets are hereby declared as two-way thoroughfares:

- a. J. Asilo Lower – from / to J. Sumulong from / to cor. Rizal Avenue
- b. S. Mateo Upper – from / to J. Sumulong from / to cor. Mahinhin

Section 6. One-Side Parking - One-side parking shall only be allowed to vehicles with four-wheels and below on the following streets:

- a. Kadalagahan Lower – Side of RPHS Taytay
- b. J. Sumulong Upper – In front of RPHS Taytay up to cor. Rizal Avenue
- c. J. Asilo Upper – In front of JVZ Emergency Side up to cor. L. Wood

Section 7. Strictly No Parking on Both Sides - Parking on both sides shall not be allowed on the following streets:

- a. J. Sumulong Lower – From L. Wood up to cor. Kadalagahan
- b. Kadalagahan Upper – From San Juan Gym going to cor. L. Wood
- c. J. Asilo Lower – Cor. J. Sumulong going to cor. Rizal Avenue
- d. Within ten (10) meters from fire hydrants
- e. Within six (6) meters from corners with TODA queue or line
- f. In front of any driveways

Section 8. Prohibition of Ambulant Vendors - Ambulant vendors shall be strictly prohibited from occupying, selling, or displaying goods along the streets and areas covered by this Ordinance, particularly within the vicinity of the Rizal Provincial Hospital System (RPHS) - Taytay, and Minor Basilica and Parish of St. John the Baptist - Taytay, Rizal. This is to ensure smooth traffic flow, pedestrian safety, and unobstructed access for emergency vehicles.

However, special permits issued by the Office of the Municipal Mayor may be granted to vendors in cases of special occasions, community activities, or officially sanctioned events, subject to conditions that will not compromise public safety, traffic management, and emergency access.

Section 9. Exemption - Ambulances, fire trucks, police and military vehicles on official functions, rescue vehicles, vehicles used by medical practitioners in an emergency, and private vehicles in emergency situations are exempted from the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 10. Implementing Office - The Taytay Municipal Police Station, Municipal Public Safety Office (MPSO), Smile Traffic Action Group (STAG), in coordination with Barangay Traffic Management Offices (BTMOs) and Barangay Public Safety Offices (BPSOs), shall implement the necessary rules and regulations to effectively enforce this Ordinance.

Section 11. Posting - Proper posting of this Ordinance shall be undertaken, including the installation of visible traffic signages such as One-Way, No Entry, and Parking Regulation signs in affected streets within the Municipality of Taytay.

In addition, the Taytay Public Information Office shall ensure that the public is adequately informed through the use of digital platforms, tarpaulins, and flyers within the municipality.

Section 12. Repealing Clause - All ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


Section 13. Penalty - Violation of this ordinance or part thereof shall be penalized in accordance with Ordinance No. 8, series of 2019 (Municipal Traffic Code), specifically:

- Section 1, D-66. Illegal or unauthorized counterflow of traffic – ₱ 2,500.00.
- Other applicable penalties under the same traffic code shall apply depending on the nature of the violation.

Section 14. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after proper posting and information dissemination. A one (1) month pilot implementation (dry run) shall be observed, during which only warnings shall be issued. Full enforcement and penalties shall take effect thereafter.
