RESOLUTION NO. 279 series of 2021

A RESOLUTION PROMPTING THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, BUSINESS PERMIT AND LICENSING OFFICE, PNP TAYTAY AND ALL SANGGUNIANG BARANGAYS TO CURB THE PROLIFERATION OF ILLEGAL VENDORS SELLING FROM THEIR PARKED MOTORIZED VEHICLES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL

WHEREAS, REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7394 or THE CONSUMER ACT OF THE PHILIPPINES declares that it is the policy of the State to protect the interests of the consumer, promote his general welfare and to establish standards of conduct for business and industry. Towards this end, the State shall implement measures to achieve the following objectives: (a) protection against hazards to health and safety; (b) protection against deceptive, unfair and unconscionable sales acts and practices;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Taytay, having the appellation as a Business-Friendly Municipality, has the thrust to give protection and support to legitimate entrepreneurs with registered businesses in this town;

WHEREAS, there have been several reports of incidences where parked motorized vehicles would have its rear doors opened upward displaying different items for sale without any permits or business registrations affecting legitimate merchants and traders who abide by the regulations and laws;

WHEREAS, the patrons or buyers likewise have no coverage of protection because the consumer products have not undergone processes that determine conformity to established quality and safety standards as prescribed by law and the sources of products, as well as the identity of the unregistered sellers are difficult to establish;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in a session duly assembled, hereby PROMPTS THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, BUSINESS PERMIT AND LICENSING OFFICE, PNP TAYTAY AND ALL SANGGUNIANG BARANGAYS TO CURB THE PROLIFERATION OF ILLEGAL VENDORS SELLING FROM THEIR PARKED MOTORIZED VEHICLES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of the Resolution be furnished to the Executive Department, the PNP Taytay and all the Sangguniang Barangays in Taytay for their information and appropriate action.
