## **RESOLUTION NO. 313 series of 2021**

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HON. GEORGE RICARDO R. GACULA II IN COORDINATION TO THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE TO CONSIDER ESTABLISHING A PERMANENT POLICE SUB-STATION / POLICE UNIT OFFICE ALONG EXODUS FLOODWAY, BARANGAY STA. ANA, TAYTAY, RIZAL

WHEREAS, the highly populated Exodus community in Barangay Sta. Ana, Municipality of Taytay is one of the nearest areas in the metropolis and along the boundary lines of the next town Cainta;

WHEREAS, the area along the Exodus is also the gateway of the commuters entering the eastern part of Rizal Province from the Southern part of Laguna and other Calabarzon municipalities and vice versa as exit way of these commuters going back to Manila;

WHEREAS, there is a given statistical review showing that the ideal ratio of the ratio of the police-to-population (uniformed personnel) strength of the Philippine National Police is one in every five hundred people (1:500) in a certain community to be able to provide the basic police visibility thereby promoting peace and order in the area;

WHEREAS, data shows that there is tremendous increase in cases related to police matters in the area and the 11<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan finds it just and proper to legislate a way to address the need to show permanent visibility of police as well as police forces along Exodus Floodway;

WHEREAS, to be able to spread the services of the uniformed man within the locality, the presence of a permanent station in the area will address the concern of the community at the swiftest time needed and lessen the effect of the unserved casualties;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the 11<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby REQUESTS THE HONORABLE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HON. GEORGE RICARDO R. GACULA II IN COORDINATION TO THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE TO CONSIDER ESTABLISHING A PERMANENT POLICE SUB-STATION / POLICE UNIT OFFICE ALONG EXODUS FLOODWAY, BARANGAY STA. ANA, TAYTAY, RIZAL.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to send copies of the Resolution to the Office of the Provincial and Local National Police and to the Office of the Local Chief Executive Hon. George Ricardo R. Gacula II for its immediate consideration and appropriate action.
