RESOLUTION NO. 324 series of 2021

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MR. JOMAR MALLARI, WHO WAS AMONG THE SEVEN PHILIPPINE GENERAL HOSPITAL NURSES THAT RESCUED AND SAVED THE THIRTY-FIVE (35) INFANT PATIENTS DURING THE FIRE WHICH OCCURRED LAST MAY 16, 2021 AT PHILIPPINE GENERAL HOSPITAL

WHEREAS, on the wee hours of May 16, 2021 a fire broke out in the operating room of Philippine General Hospital which is currently considered as the biggest COVID-19 patient referral in the country;

WHEREAS, amidst the confusion, chaos and the billowing thick smoke that enveloped the facility, the seven nurses, among them was Mr. Jomar Mallari, now in his seven years as nurse in





the PGH and currently residing at Taytay, Rizal, have rescued and saved thirty-five (35) infant patients in Neonatal Intensive Care Unit of the Hospital, defying the risks to their own safety;

WHEREAS, accounts of the incident revealed that nurses Kathrina Bianca Macababbad and Jomar Mallari have to rush back and forth to the fourth floor of the hospital for five times before they could get all their patients out;

WHEREAS, the acts displayed by those nurses who braved themselves and selflessly put their life on the line during such startling occurrence, are step further to their oath in saving their patients' lives, and thus deserving not only admiration and praise but beyond doubt, worthy of emulation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby COMMENDS MR. JOMAR MALLARI, WHO WAS AMONG THE SEVEN PHILIPPINE GENERAL HOSPITAL NURSES THAT RESCUED AND SAVED THE THIRTY-FIVE (35) INFANT PATIENTS DURING THE FIRE WHICH OCCURRED LAST MAY 16, 2021 AT PHILIPPINE GENERAL HOSPITAL.
