RESOLUTION NO. 340 series of 2021

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HON. FRANCISCO DUQUE III, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THRU ITS OIC-DIRECTOR IV, DR. PAULA PAZ M. SYDIONCO MD., TO CONSIDER THE ADVISABILITY OF EXPEDITING THE DELIVERY OF, AND INCREASING THE ALLOCATION OF COVID-19 VACCINE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL

WHEREAS, consequent to the relentless efforts of Taytay Municipal Government in persuading its inhabitants to take part in, and be vaccinated against COVID-19, its Taytay Trail Website for COVID-19 Vaccine Registration are now being overwhelmed by the number of inhabitants availing for the vaccine program;

WHEREAS, observably however, the supply for, and the delivery of the needed vaccine has increasingly become unsteady, despite the municipality's readiness and capability to administer and implement the rollout of the same to the inhabitants of the municipality;

WHEREAS, records on file from the Municipal Health Office revealed that to date, out of the targeted 270,750 eligible population, only about 21,510 residents of the municipality have been vaccinated, the breakdown of which are hereunder indicated:

First dose: - - - - - 15,645 vaccinated Second dose: - - - - 5,865 vaccinated

WHEREAS, the rollout of COVID-19 vaccine in this municipality was momentarily stalled due to the lack of supply and delivery of the same, more so, its allocation could not regularly sustain the influx of the inhabitants seeking to be vaccinated;

WHEREAS, to ensure continuous implementation of the program, the supply of the vaccines must have to be readily available and reasonably sufficient to cover those who are queuing for vaccination;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby EARNESTLY REQUESTS THE HON. FRANCISCO DUQUE III, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THRU ITS OIC-DIRECTOR IV, DR. PAULA PAZ M. SYDIONCO MD., TO CONSIDER THE ADVISABILITY OF EXPEDITING THE DELIVERY OF, AND INCREASING THE ALLOCATION OF COVID-19 VACCINE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL.
