WHEREAS, the Grand Express Transport Terminal Corporation (GETTC) has applied for a Locational Clearance and Building Permit from the Municipal Government of Taytay for a proposed Privately-owned Public Transport Terminal located at Tikling, Manila East Road Barangay Dolores Taytay, Rizal;

WHEREAS, both applications were approved since the location of the proposed Privately-owned Public Transport Terminal is in line with the municipal zoning ordinance and the applicants have submitted all necessary requirements for the building permit;

WHEREAS, the GETTC is currently processing their application for a franchise to operate from the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) and is in need of this resolution from the Sangguniang Bayan where the Privately-owned Public Transport Terminal will be located;

WHEREAS, there is a strong demand for a privately-owned public transport terminal in the area especially with the upcoming operation of the MRT4 project of the Department of Transportation, which will have a terminal at the area of Tikling;

WHEREAS, the presence of a privately-owned public transport terminal in the area may contribute to mitigating traffic in the area of Tikling and to the efficiency of public commuting in the municipality;


WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the LTFRB for a franchise to operate, the Sanggunian believes that the proposed privately-owned public transport terminal will be beneficial to the commuting public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 12<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby INTERPOSES NO OBJECTION FOR THE OPERATION OF A PRIVATELY-OWNED PUBLIC TRANSPORT TERMINAL OF THE GRAND EXPRESS TRANSPORT TERMINAL CORPORATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL, PROVIDED THAT THEY COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE LTFRB FOR FRANCHISE APPLICATION.
