WHEREAS, the Grand Express Transport Terminal Corporation (GETTC) has applied for a Locational Clearance and Building Permit from the Municipal Government of Taytay for a proposed Privately-owned Public Transport Terminal located at Tikling, Manila East Road Barangay Dolores Taytay, Rizal;

WHEREAS, both applications were approved since the location of the proposed Privatelyowned Public Transport Terminal is in line with the municipal zoning ordinance and the applicants have submitted all necessary requirements for the building permit;

WHEREAS, the GETTC is currently processing their application for a franchise to operate from the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) and is in need of this resolution from the Sangguniang Bayan where the Privately-owned Public Transport Terminal will be located;

WHEREAS, there is a strong demand for a privately-owned public transport terminal in the area especially with the upcoming operation of the MRT4 project of the Department of Transportation, which will have a terminal at the area of Tikling;

WHEREAS, the presence of a privately-owned public transport terminal in the area may contribute to mitigating traffic in the area of Tikling and to the efficiency of public commuting in the municipality;

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the LTFRB for a franchise to operate, the Sanggunian believes that the proposed privately-owned public transport terminal will be beneficial to the commuting public;



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 12th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby INTERPOSES NO OBJECTION FOR THE OPERATION OF A PRIVATELY-OWNED PUBLIC TRANSPORT TERMINAL OF THE GRAND EXPRESS TRANSPORT TERMINAL CORPORATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL, PROVIDED THAT THEY COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE LTFRB FOR FRANCHISE APPLICATION.
