WHEREAS, there are several road construction projects within the municipality, initiated by both national and local government, such as road repairs, and other public works, which have resulted in several road closures and the rerouting of traffic;

WHEREAS, these ongoing projects, while essential for the development of the municipality, have also caused significant disruptions to the usual flow of traffic, particularly in areas where one-way streets and detours have been implemented as a temporary solution;

WHEREAS, despite efforts to manage traffic flow, confusion may persist among motorists and pedestrians due to the absence of clear, visible, and well-placed traffic signage indicating the changes in road directions and detour routes, which could lead to delays, traffic congestion, and potential accidents;

WHEREAS, this absence of proper signages can endanger public safety by causing drivers and pedestrians to inadvertently violate traffic rules or make unsafe decisions in unfamiliar road conditions;

WHEREAS, the installation of official and proper traffic signages, including clear markers indicating detour routes, one-way streets, and other traffic flow adjustments, would significantly improve public safety, reduce traffic-related incidents, and promote smoother movement of both vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the affected areas;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Taytay, through MPSO, has the authority and capacity to address traffic management concerns and ensure that adequate infrastructure is in place to guide motorists and pedestrians safely through temporary changes in road conditions;


WHEREAS, this august body also recommends for the MPSO to ensure that only standard traffic signage designs be used;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the 12<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in a session duly assembled, hereby HUMBLY REQUESTS THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE HON. ALLAN MARTINE S. DE LEON, MPA, THROUGH THE MUNICIPAL PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE (MPSO), TO INSTALL OFFICIAL AND PROPER SIGNAGES ALONG ONE-WAY STREETS AFFECTED BY DETOURS DUE TO ONGOING GOVERNMENT PROJECTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL.
